Highly recommended for students of the human condition - both professional and avocational. Lewis's Mere Christianity: A Biography. Egyptology and Assyriology thus had already developed systematic excavations on a large scale even before the notion of prehistory was formulated.

Just in the last three years a flood of new scientific findings - driven by revelation.
