The print of the foot in every respect is an exact resemblance of that of a foal of considerable size, with this small difference perhaps, that the sole seems a little longer or not so round; but, as no Hoof Prints in the Snow has had the good fortune as yet to have obtained a glimpse of this creature, nothing more can be said of its shape or dimensions; only it has been remarked, from the depth to which the feet sunk in the snow, that it must be a beast of considerable size; it has been observed also, that its walk is not like that of the generality of quadrupeds, but that it is more like the bounding or limping of a hare when not scared or pursued.

Webbing: Webbing is usually found on an animal that frequently swims in the water.

Many weasels hop, so the tracks come in pairs. Busk tell of how they followed the tracks with hounds. Roe deer tracks are around 5cm long and 4cm wide, while for a fallow deer tracks are around 7cm long and 5cm wide.

Their feet tend to land side-by-side producing a repeating series of four distinct prints left behind after a mouse leaps resembles that of a cloven animal, due to the motions of its limbs when it jumps.
