These figures should, however, be treated with caution. Sometimes the impact of changes in child-related benefit levels are compounded by other changes to social support when the recipient has multiple challenges. Since the establishment of the first social supermarket in at least seven parent schemes have emerged in England, each with branches, franchises and plans for expansion in other low income areas, some of which are part-funded or supported by local government.
